

Congregation Update – October 14, 2011

Across the ELCA's 10,400 congregations:

- 533 congregations have passed a 2nd vote and have been officially removed from the roster
- 60% of those who have disaffiliated have affiliated with LCMC

In 2009 the NC Synod included 238 congregations. The Synod now includes 204 congregations and 6 Synodically Authorized Worshipping Communities:

- 34 congregations in North Carolina have voted to disaffiliate and their departure has been approved by the NC Synod Council:
