Dear Parents,

Our trip to the LYO Assembly at the Embassy Suites, Greensboro is almost upon us. Here are some informational items you'll want to have:

1 – When are we leaving and coming home? We'll leave from the church at \_\_\_\_\_ on Friday. We'll leave Greensboro at 10:30am on Sunday and return home by \_\_\_\_\_. You'll need to send \$\_\_\_\_\_ for food during the trip. (All meals during the event are covered in registration.)

2 – What to bring? The kids sleep in a hotel suite. Six to a room with 2 double beds & sleeper sofa OR 4 youth and one adult. Each needs toiletries, something to sleep in, appropriate swimsuit for indoor pool, casual clothes with the exception of the banquet – this year it's a pick your decade dinner so mismatched clothes are o.k. (50's, 60's, etc.) It may be cold - a coat would be a good idea.

3 – A medical release is necessary. You can fill it out at the church before we go, but it will require your medical insurance company, their address and your policy number. You will have to fill out a NC Synod form. Please remember: we can't leave without it.

5 – What to leave home: alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons of any kind – pocket knives too.
